Subject: Unauthorized Use of Copyrighted Materials

Current Church policy provides that materials produced by the Church are thoroughly reviewed and approved for clearance of copyright and data privacy rights (see *Church Handbook of Instructions*, 149-50).

Individual Church members and Church units may produce newsletters and other materials using excerpts from written Church publications for personal or local use. However, all other copyrighted works, particularly including music, video, or images should not be included in locally produced materials unless specifically authorized by the Church Intellectual Property Office. When Church units produce and distribute unauthorized materials in DVD, CD, or other media formats in violation of Church policy, they expose the Church to liability and those who produced the unauthorized work to personal liability.
